

DISTRICT 3 FALL DINNER MEETING

NOVEMBER 14, 2024

Vice President Dale Crouch opened the meeting by welcoming everyone. Tom Gilkey led everyone in the pledge and Gary Bartlet the invocation.

Dinner was served.

Roll call was conducted by Lynn Freeman with all board members were in attendance except for President Brad Sawchuk and Director Bev Gamnis.

The minutes of our spring dinner meeting held on 2/22/2024 were read by Secretary Lynn Freeman. A motion was made by Tom Gilkey to accept the minutes as read, it was seconded by Linda Stoneburner, carried, and passed.

Donna Crouch presented the Treasurers report period ending 23/24 season balance was \$13,155. Gross profit on the sale of wax was \$6240, the expenses were \$4640, and total operating costs \$1599. Basically, at the end of last year we were able to make a profit of \$400.00 more than the year before.

As Donna is the membership coordinator there are couple of little notes, to date this year we have 260 members signed up, which is kind of on par for where we were last year, so the numbers really haven't changed. Also please use the membership sheets on the website to add membership and if you need to drop them off, we are at lot 520 with a locked mailbox to leave monies in.

A motion was made by Bill Stoneburner to accept the report, it was seconded by Grieg Carter, carried, and passed.

Committee Reports:

League Chair: Dawn Cappleman is stepping down from League Coordinator. Please have anyone interested step forward. She will assist in any way possible for the new person to take over. The Arizona Shuffleboard Association Website, Yuma page will have as up to date as possible the standing of each league posted on it.
