Dale Crouch is our 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President and the Webmaster for District 3 and the State Website other than District 2. Dale did a presentation on our website's layout and features.

Committee Reports:

**League Chair:** Linda Stoneburner is taking over for Dawn Cappleman next year and as of this meeting she has 14 Rosters for next year's season. Dawn wants all the team captains to make sure they have given Linda their phone numbers and email addresses. Dawn also thanked everyone for her time as league coordinator and all the support that was received from everyone.

**Hall of Fame:** Brad Sawchuk is the representative for District 3 at the state level in Hall of Fame. March 1<sup>st</sup> at the state meeting we will be voting on those members that have been nominated. There are 3 nominations, including Linda Stoneburner from our district. He sees no reason why she will not be elected to the Hall of Fame.
